


#### **Settled Students**

#### **K12 Mathematics Musings**

In mathematics K12 students been learning about position. Children by the end of Kindergarten should be able to give and follow simple directions, describe position using everyday language and use the terms left and right to describe position in relation to themselves. By the end of Year 1 students should be able to describe positions from the perspective of a person facing in the opposite direction and describe a path from one location to another. By the end of Year 2 students should be able to interpret maps of familiar places and represent the position of objects in models, drawings and photographs. You can help your child by using the terms 'left' and 'right' when giving directions and talk about where things are positioned in maps and photographs. Included here is a photo of the children sitting around a desk to start your conversation.
