Term 4 Homework Overview

This term homework will involve:

K-6 – spelling list LSCWC (look, say, cover, write, check)

K-1 – homework worksheet (based on spelling sounds)

2-6 – time table CD to take home and be listening to (this will be provided hopefully by week 2)

As a "Homework Project" all students from K-6 will be required to complete an at home homework task during week 2 or 3. This task will follow on from in class learning. It will be completed using an ipad, which students will take home from school.

Students will be responsible for taking a school ipad home, completing the homework task and returning the ipad to school. The task will not take students very long to complete. This task will encourage the students to explore the ipads in their own time and to share their technology skills with others at home.
