### **Leaving the School Grounds**

At the end of the day students are required to line up to leave the school grounds.

- One line is for bus travellers.
- One line is for walkers, riders or people being picked up from school.

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Teachers walk the bus line out first, to board the bus safely. The other line of non-bus travellers is required to wait, inside the school gate until the bus has left the bus zone.

Students walking are then safely crossed over the road, riders supervised as they leave the school grounds and students being picked up head towards the vehicle they are travelling in.

Please remind students of this. In the past week we have had some walkers, eager to get out of the school grounds before the bus has left. If you are picking children up, please also be aware of these safe school practices.

If your child has alternate arrangements at the end of the day, eg being picked up by somebody other than a parent or walking somewhere, please ensure the school is notified to ensure student safety.



### **Maths**


In Miss Monks maths sessions students have been learning about Three Dimensional shapes. Students have been using 3D models to name shapes, identify attributes of shapes and link these shapes to their everyday lives. Students have also been using the net of a shape to build 3D shapes.





### In the classroom...Technology

Students have been utilising technology in the classroom to enhance their learning. Each student has access to a desktop computer with head phones. Students use educational programs such as Reading Eggs, Maths Seeds, Reading Eggspress, Spellodrome. Mathletics and programs require a login, which the school has purchased for each student. This enables students to engage in interactive learning that is at their individual academic level. Students are able to access these programs at home if they choose to by using either a computer or ipad and their login. Please contact the school if you would like copies of your child's logins to be sent home.





Over the past few weeks students have been further developing their typing skills. This has involved students selecting a piece of their own writing and typing the writing on a computer. Students have then been learning how to save their work and print.

Students each have access to the online Typing Tournament program which develops typing skills.
